It was Henson's life experiences that inspired Ms. Stowe's creation of the character Uncle Tom in her 1852 outcry against slavery.



Along the way we'll share an exciting evening of dinner and theater, with a live show at the beautifully restored Victoria Playhouse and dinner at an adjacent restaurant.
